

What Happens if My Vehicle Doesn't Pass a Safety Inspection?

If your vehicle will not pass safety inspection, our trained staff will be able to help explain the problems you have and how to correct it. We will address any questions or concerns you may have.

According to the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation Website: https://www.dmv.pa.gov

- A vehicle **must pass** an emission test before an annual safety inspection sticker can be applied to the vehicle.
- A vehicle **must pass** a safety inspection before an annual sticker can be applied to the vehicle.
- All Stickers **Expire** on the **last day of the month** and year listed on the sticker adhered to the windshield.
- All necessary repairs **must be** completed before an annual safety inspection sticker can be issued.

Miller Tire and Auto Guidelines

- If Miller Tire and Auto completes the repairs the re-inspection is free within 14 days of the original inspection, plus the cost of the sticker.
- If the customer completes the repairs the re-inspection will cost ½ the regular inspection price, plus the cost of the sticker.
- If after 14 days the re-inspection will be full price
